The town requests your input about the location, character, and timing of future Summerfield development.

- The plan may include provisions for the amount, intensity, character, and timing of land use proposed for residences, businesses, agriculture, major traffic, utilities, community facilities, public grounds, parks and recreation, floodplains, etc.
- It will help meet housing needs of present and future residents—conservation of housing and the accommodation of expected new housing in different dwelling types and at appropriate densities for various income levels.
- It will be a tool for the movement of people and goods, which may include roadways, pedestrian and bikeway systems, and other similar facility uses.
- It's about protection of natural and historic resources: wetlands, aquifer recharge zones, woodlands, agricultural land, floodplains, natural areas, and historic sites.
