12:40 pm Shared Gifting Update

- Subcommittee decided to focus on the following counties in the next round of shared gifting: Rockingham, Stokes, Surry, Yadkin.
- Presented Round 2 proposal, a different model than shared gifting. The proposed model would be a 1-hour meeting, connecting projects and networking with incentives for participation and a random drawing.
- Feedback from council below:
 - o Cleaner and more efficient. Easier to implement.
 - Ease of application is appealing. Possibly incorporate community voting.
 - Shared gifting more feasible with in person. We need to adapt this for Zoom, recorded presentations could be an option. Lottery may not be the best option; we don't want something not to get funded due to chance.
 - Timing of first round shared gifting may have been part of the issue. Lottery removes individuality of it.
 - Does changing the model affect our funding agreement? No, our funder wants us to be successful and put the money to work to strengthen food work in smaller counties. We want to come up with round 2 in a way that we can have more than one applicant in each county and strengthen local capacity.
 - Can we advertise more on social media, get the word out better? Shift to one day instead of two?
 - o Can we bring in more involvement? County Managers, etc?
 - Create visual to share out to inform.
 - o Increase dollar amount
 - More emphasis on marketing. Groups may not be well developed yet, and money may not be the best remedy. Marketing dollars could be used to make groups feel more authentic. In person- a luncheon or some way to get people in a room to connect- would be more alluring. Lift up their work! May be more valuable than money.
 - o Lotteries may make groups feel devalued. Could hurt trust.
 - One thing to consider as a goal is the relationship building piece- that moves at a different speed. One event is not sufficient to build relationships. Creates the basis for future collaborations. May not achieve in this one or even two meetings.
