





Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF) 2023

Eligibility

The North Carolina General Assembly funds PARTF each year at different levels. PARTF provides dollar-for-dollar matching grants to local governments. A project must be located on a single park site and applicant must have legal control of the park property where PARTF facilities will be located.

Target Area

North Carolina counties and incorporated municipalities. Public authorities, as defined by N.C. General Statute 159-7, are also eligible if they are authorize to acquire land or develop recreational facilities for the general public.

Application Process

All cities and counties in North Carolina are invited to apply for PARTF using this application package. The N.C. Division of Parks and Recreation provides technical assistance to local governments through a contract with Recreation Resources Services at N.C. State University.

- Application are due by 5pm May 1, 2023.

 Grant Amount
 - Award maximum is \$500,000
- Match

An applicant must match the grant dollar-for-dollar, 50 percent of the total cost of the project, and may contribute more than 50 percent.

Target Area

North Carolina counties and incorporated municipalities

Focus Area

- Acquisition or renovation of existing parks previously developed with LWCF assistance.
- Grants can be used to acquire land for a public park.
- Develop outdoor recreation and support facilities; or a combination of both.

Purpose

- Provides for permanent recreation improvements in a 50:50 cost share arrangement
- Can be used for acquisition, development or renovation of facilities.
- Applicants can request a maximum grant of \$500,000 with each application.

Match

An applicant must match the grant with a minimum of 50 percent. Due to a federal share cap of \$500,000, a greater match is required for projects that exceed total costs of \$1 million.
