EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2019, the Transportation Planning Division of the N.C. Department of Transportation (NCDOT), the Northwest Piedmont Rural Planning Organization (RPO), Davie County, Surry County, Yadkin County and their municipalities began a Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) study for the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Region.



The Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Regional CTP includes identified transportation system needs, as well as possible solutions, to support anticipated growth and development over a 25 to 30-year timeframe. Various modes of transportation were evaluated, and recommendations were made, including: highway, public transportation, bicycle/pedestrian. The impacts of other modes of travel, such as airports, play significant roles in moving people and freight in North Carolina and in the CTP.

The Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Regional CTP was adopted locally and by the North Carolina Board of Transportation in MONTH 20XX.

This plan does not cover routine maintenance or minor operations issues. Refer to the Contacts Information Appendix for contact information on these types of issues.



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Chapter ONE Introductions and Overview


The Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) is North Carolina's multi-modal long range transportation plan. The CTP is mutually adopted and identifies transportation system needs, as well as solutions, to support anticipated growth and development over a 25-30-year timeframe.

PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW

This plan is developed by NCDOT, the Northwest Piedmont Rural Planning Organization (RPO), Davie County, Surry County, Yadkin County, and all municipalities within the three-county region, with the support of the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Regional CTP Steering Committee.

The CTP supports the community's adopted vision and goals by integrating land use and transportation planning. This plan should be used by local officials to ensure that planned transportation facilities reflect the needs of the public, while minimizing the disruption to local residents, businesses and environmental resources. The CTP process is designed to provide useful information into the project development process.

When starting a CTP study, officials form a steering committee of individuals who represent the various stakeholders of the community. NCDOT and other local planning staff also participate. The committee develops the draft vision, goals, objectives, and performance measures. These are further refined with input from residents and then used to guide the development and evaluation of the CTP.

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Chapter TWO Existing and Future Conditions

This chapter summarizes the current and future conditions of the transportation system in the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Regional CTP.

To meet future travel demand, reliable forecasts of future travel patterns are needed to estimate congestion.

For highways, this is usually accomplished through mainly a capacity deficiency analysis (which is a measure of how the facility is operating based on existing and project traffic) and a traffic crash analysis.

For multi-modal uses, the distance between destinations, and roadway characteristics, are key components.

This information, along with population growth, economic development potential, and land use trends is used to determine the potential impacts on the future transportation system.

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PUBLIC, COMMUNITY, STAKEHOLDER INVOLVEMENT SUMMARY

Public involvement is a key element in the transportation planning process.

Public input was an overarching component of this plan, collected through multiple avenues and methods. This plan will affect those who live, work, own a business, play, and/or enjoy leisure activities in the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Region. Feedback from the public guided the creation of this plan's project recommendations. A full summary of public outreach can be found in the Public Involvement Appendix.

Throughout the course of the study, the NCDOT Transportation Planning Division cooperatively worked with the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Regional CTP Steering Committee. The committee provided information on current local plans, developed transportation vision and goals, discussed population and employment projections, and produced <u>CTP Project Recommendations.</u>

COMMUNITY UNDERSTANDING

A Community Understanding Report (CUR) was created which summarized local information about population, employment, expected growth areas, schools, and transportation methods. This report can be found in the <u>Community Understanding Appendix</u>.

In developing this plan, the timeframe used to project travel demand was from 2017 to 2045. Growth in the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Region is expected to occur along the major highway corridors.

NC State Statute §136-66.2 specifically states that NCDOT may participate in the development and adoption of a CTP when all governments within the area covered by the plan have adopted land development plans adopted within the previous five years.

During the CTP process, recommendations were developed with community character and land use in mind. Surry County focused its efforts on areas around U.S. 601 and showcasing natural beauty through expanding its trail and greenway network. Yadkin County aimed to preserve its rural character. Davie County expects growth to occur near and around the Mocksville and Cooleemee areas and the U.S. 601 and U.S. 64 corridors.

Each mode of travel covered by the comprehensive transportation plan has been independently analyzed for both current and forecast conditions. In addition, there has been a review/assessment of the interaction between modes as appropriate.

CHAPTER TWO EXISTING AND FUTURE CONDITIONS

HIGHWAY ANALYSIS SUMMARY

Roadway System Capacity Deficiencies

Comparing roadway demand (vehicle volumes) to roadway supply (carrying capacity) is one of the primary measures of roadway performance.

Capacity deficiencies occur when the traffic volume approaches or exceeds the road's capacity. The highway analysis assumes 2020-2029 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects that are in the right-of-way acquisition phase or are under construction will be completed by the future year (2045).

Planning Level Intersection Assessment

Roadway intersections in the CTP were assessed using a high level analysis, including the type of facility and current delay. The recommendations identify a possible solution to a problem or "identified need." The improvement types can be interchanges, overpasses, limited movement and all movement intersections. Refer to the <u>Definitions Appendix</u> for definitions of any terms

Planning Level Traffic Crash Assessment

Traffic crashes are often used as an indicator for locating congestion and roadway problems. Safety is at the core of the NCDOT's mission of connecting people, products, and places; and therefore, there are several ongoing programs and initiatives within NCDOT that specifically address safety. Planning level locations in the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Region which occurred between January 1, 2014 and December 31, 2018, are shown on the Planning Level Crash Locations Map. The CTP Steering Committee reviewed this map, which can be found in the Transportation Planning Analysis Data Appendix.

Since safety concerns often need more immediate attention than long-range projects identified during a CTP, all public comments concerning safety received during the development of the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Regional CTP were shared with NCDOT Division 9 or 11 for review and consideration.

Bridge Deficiency Assessment

There are 151 structurally deficient and functionally obsolete bridges that were identified. Refer to the <u>Transportation Planning Analysis Data Appendix</u> for more detailed bridge deficiency information and their relationship to CTP project proposals.

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BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ANALYSIS SUMMARY

CHAPTER TWO EXISTING AND FUTURE CONDITIONS

Bicyclists and pedestrians are elements of the transportation system in North Carolina. Many communities are working to improve mobility for bicyclists and pedestrians.

The N.C. 4 Bike Route (North Line Trace) runs through Surry County, from Wilkes County to Stokes County, connecting Pilot Mountain, Ararat, Black Water, Dobson, and Salem Fork. The Granite City Greenway, the Ararat River Greenway, and the Emily B. Taylor Greenway are most popular in the Mount Airy/Surry County area, providing active transportation options to the community such as walking, jogging, and biking. The 2021 Yadkin Valley Regional Bicycle Plan's major proposals connect all the municipalities within the planning area, which includes the Yadkin River State Trail. There is a proposal for a multi-use path (MUP) bridge over the Yadkin River along I-77, connecting Surry and Yadkin Counties. All recommendations from adopted CTPs and local plans were considered in the regional plan.

The N.C. 2 Bike Route (Mountains to Sea) runs through Yadkin County, from Iredell County to Forsyth County. In the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Region, existing sidewalks are concentrated in the downtown areas. There are a few gaps between sidewalk segments, and other segments do not extend all the way to desired destinations.

In Davie County, there are six proposed greenway trails (Mocksville Greenring, Cooleemee, Cedar Creek, Bear Creek, Dutchman Creek, and Farmington), along with municipal bike and/or pedestrian plans from the Yadkin Valley Regional Bike Plan, the Davie County CTP, and local plans that were considered.





PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION ANALYSIS SUMMARY



Public Transportation, currently operated by Yadkin Valley Economic Development District, Inc. (YVEDDI) and the NCDOT Integrated Mobility Division (IMD), provides demand response services throughout the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties CTP study region.

The Surry County Express is a fixed-route bus service between Mount Airy and Winston-Salem, currently operated by the Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART).

RAIL

Currently there is no passenger rail service to the region.



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AIRPORTS

The Davie County Airport (847) is a privately owned, public-use airport located five miles (8 km) northeast of the central business district (CBD) of Mocksville, in Davie County. It covers 100 acres and with one asphalt runway (runway 9/27) which is 2,943 feet in length and has no control tower. It operates from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. with after-hours service upon request. The Mount Airy Surry County Airport (KMWK) is a public airport owned jointly by Surry County and the City of Mount Airy, located adjacent to the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains with a great view of picturesque Pilot Mountain, and three miles southeast of Mount Airy. It covers 147 acres, with an asphalt surface runway (runway 18/36) which is 4,301 feet in length and has no control tower. It operates from 8 a.m. to SS with after-hours service available upon request. Mobility and access to the airports were considered in the development of the CTP recommendations. The table below shows airports near municipalities in the CTP.


Major generators of goods in the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties
Region were identified, along with their proximity to nearby major roadways.

Based on the data, most truck freight movement used the following roadways: I-40, I-77, I-74/U.S. 52, U.S. 421.

I-40 in Davie County, I-77 in Surry and Yadkin Counties, I-77/U.S. 52 in Surry County and U.S. 421 in Yadkin County are part of the Primary Highway Freight System (PHFS). These facilities are based on freight tonnage and value, truck traffic, access factors and network connectivity.

CTP Project Proposals

Each mode of travel included in the Davie, Surry, and Yadkin Counties Regional Comprehensive Transportation Plan (Highway, Public Transportation, Bicycle / Pedestrian) have been independently analyzed for current and future conditions.











Projected 2045 needs for each mode of transportation were analyzed and project recommendations developed through consideration of benefits and potential impacts including an extensive public engagement process. The results of this analysis are found in Figure 1.

NCDOT PROJECT DELIVERY PROCESS

Years of extensive planning, study and work occur before NCDOT begins building a roadway. The process, known as the Project Development Process, begins with the department assisting municipalities and regions in developing Comprehensive Transportation Plans, which are long range plans that identify area transportation needs and priorities.

Once a project is programmed for funding, NCDOT initiates studies and the project enters into the environmental analysis and development phase. The process includes getting feedback from the public and analyzing how a proposed project might affect people living and working in the area, along with its environmental impact.

Once the final design location has been determined and NCDOT acquires necessary property to accommodate the project and awards a construction contract ("Let"). Then, construction begins.

The typical NCDOT Project Delivery Process is shown in the figure below.






Facility Types and Control of Access (Listed in Order of Mobility Function)

UNADDRESSED DEFICIENCIES

This section identifies any deficiencies that were identified during the development of the plan, but, for varying reasons, recommendations were not made.

• In Surry County, the following roads are expected to be near capacity by 2045. However, it was determined that the best course of action would be to monitor traffic issues and make no recommendation at this time:

N.C. 103/Pine Street (SR 2432) from U.S. 52 Business to South Street (SR 1669) is expected to be near capacity by 2045. Given the low speeds and Pine Street's nature as an east-west main street through Mount Airy and limited room for widening, it was determined that there was no need for any recommendation to be made at this time.

N.C. 104 (Riverside Drive) from N.C. 103 to Linville Road (SR 1727) is expected to be near capacity by 2045. It was determined that the best course of action would be to monitor traffic issues on N.C. 104 and make no recommendation at this time.

N.C. 268 (South Key Street) from Shoals Road (SR 2048) to Main Street (SR 1857) is expected to be near or over capacity by 2045. N.C. 268 is currently a two-lane facility with a center turn lane and low speeds. The corridor is primarily commercial in nature with some residential, west of Pilot Mountain. No recommendation was made at this time, but the deficiency will be reviewed during the next CTP update.

North Main Street (SR 1708) from U.S. 52 to Springs Road (SR 1708) is expected to be near capacity by 2045. North Main Street corridor passes through a built residential area. Addressing the deficiency through widening will be of significant impact. It was determined that it would be best to monitor traffic issues on North Main Street and make no recommendation at this time.

East Atkins Street (SR 1100) from U.S. 601 Business to U.S. 601 is expected to be near capacity by 2045. East Atkins Street is currently a two-lane facility with a center turn lane and low speeds. The corridor is primarily commercial in nature with some residential, east of Dobson. It was determined that it would be best to monitor traffic issues on East Atkins Street (SR 1100) and make no recommendation at this time.

U.S. 21 BUS (North Bridge Street) from Commerce St to N.C. 268 is projected to be near or over capacity by 2045. Channelization and lane re-striping, to control traffic flow along the corridor, was implemented recently. It was then determined that there was no need for any recommendation to be made at this time.

Rockford Street (SR 1100) from U.S. 52 to North Main Street is projected to be near or over capacity by 2045. Rockford Streetcorridor passes through a built area that is both residential and commercial. Addressing the deficiency through widening will be of significant impact. It was determined that it would be best to monitor traffic issues on Rockford Street and make no recommendation at this time.

♥ In Yadkin County, U.S. 601 from Lee Avenue (SR 1146) to Old U.S. 421 (SR 1314) is expected to be near capacity by 2045. Given that the facility currently has two through lanes and a center turn lane and that it operates reasonably well, it was determined that there was no need for any recommendation to be made at this time.
