# Goals vs. Objectives

### The main differences between goals and objectives are:

- •Goals refer to the desired outcome, while **objectives** refer to the specific actions and accomplishments that lead to the outcome.
- •Goals are more broad and general, while objectives are more specific and measurable.
- •Goals require conceptual thinking, while objectives require strategic thinking.
- •Goals can be either tangible or intangible, while objectives are always tangible.

### GOAL

- To provide effective, efficient, and safe community facilities to sustain quality-of-life for Pleasant Garden residents.
- CF1. Provide adequate and cost effective public services and facilities.
- **CF2.** Ensure the provision of adequate utilities to meet the basic needs of Pleasant Garden residents.
- **CF3.** Provide parks and recreational opportunities for all ages within walking distance to all neighborhoods, and increase access to recreational facilities with sidewalks, bikeways, and greenways.
- **CF4.** Fully utilize Town Hall and property to provide a range of recreation and services to town citizens.



# **Historic and Cultural Resources**

### GOAL

- To preserve, protect, and promote the historic and cultural resources of Pleasant Garden for future generations.
- HC1. Encourage the preservation of historic structures in Pleasant Garden.
- **HC2.** Preserve historic artifacts and oral history.
- **HC3.** Provide additional cultural opportunities for Pleasant Garden residents and visitors.



## **Environment and Natural Resources**

### GOAL

- To encourage environmentally sound development and protect the rural atmosphere and abundant open space in the town.
- **EN1.** Protect water quality and quantity.
- EN2. Preserve open space with innovative site planning and subdivision design.
- **EN3.** Encourage farmland preservation.
- **EN4.** Promote litter control and community clean-up.
