Gearing up for the Next Round of Safe Streets & Roads for All (SS4A) Funding: Due August 29, 2024

The U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) continues to invest in local, regional and tribal road safety via the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program. NCDOT Finalizes Strategic Plan for Autonomous Transportation

NCDOT recently released its <u>Advanced Transportation Mobility Strategic Plan</u>, to improve transportation by exploring the use of innovative air and ground mobility technologies. <u>Advance Mobility NC</u> aims to leverage the work of NCDOT's Aviation, Integrated Mobility and Rail divisions to create a multimodal transportation system that improves the movement of people and freight. The new strategic plan outlines actions to integrate cutting-edge technologies such as connected and automated vehicles, electric zero-emission aircraft, and other innovations into the state's transportation infrastructure.

NCDOT Integrated Mobility Division (IMD) Programs

In 2023, the NCDOT IMD developed a pilot project, NCDOT Interim Design Safety Pilot Project, that evaluated the process for deploying low-cost, interim design safety countermeasures on state-owned and maintained roadways. Foundational to the approach of this project were the goals of the Technology and Innovation Deployment Program (TIDP) that emphasized innovative practices, improvements to safety, quick construction/ deployment, new tools and techniques, and improvements to mobility. State Street-Aid (Powell Bill) Program

<u>Powell Bill allocations</u> are made to incorporated municipalities which establish their eligibility and qualify per NCGS § 136-41.1 through 136-41.4. The funds can be used for Primarily for the resurfacing of streets; Maintaining, repairing, constructing, reconstructing, or widening of any street/public thoroughfare, and other necessary appurtenances within the corporate limits of the municipality; Planning, construction and maintenance of bikeways, greenways or Sidewalks.
