The purpose of the Annual Action Plan is to specify how the Surry County Housing Consortium will address housing and community needs for the use of the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program.

For FY 2024-2025, the SCHC anticipates receiving \$545,657.64 in HOME funds. Citizens and interested parties are encouraged to examine and submit written comments on the proposed 2024-2025 Annual Action Plan for the HOME Program. Digital copies are available by email request. The Annual Action Plan Draft is subject to revisions. If funding is again adjusted by HUD, the contingency plan is to adjust all changes to activities proportionally to the prescribed decrease or increase.

A 30-day comment period commenced on July 11, 2024, and ends August 12, 2024.
