SUBJECT: Exterior Signs for PTRC's New Building

PTRC offered an RFP for the exterior and interior signage for the new building. PTRC received two bids on the RFP for the property located at 1398 Carrollton Crossing, Kernersville, NC. Exterior signage includes two logo signs 2-sets 4" deep logo and 4" deep unlit letters all fabricated aluminum and stud mounted. Height of logo is 6 feet; height of letters is approximately 16 inches; overall length of assembly is approximately 26'6". All parts will be painted with Matthews brand (or equivalent) brand sign paint and logo graphics will be 3 M (or equivalent) digital print applied. There will be one logo on front of building and one on side facing Highway 66. Also included is the code required address signage of 1398.

Interior signage consists of code required signs, i.e. electrical, elevators, restrooms and evacuation. In addition there will be room number signs 5" X 2.5" in wood grain to match door colors.
