#### **Action Items**

*I.* TAC Minutes – June 17, 2015

### II. FY 15-16 Budget Amendment

The NWPRPO dues previously adopted by the TAC were overcalculated. Elizabeth Jernigan requested members approve an amendment to approve the revised budget, slightly reducing dues for members. Kevin Austin made a motion to approve the amendment, Sharon Conaway seconded the motion. All were in favor.

### III. CMAQ Resolution of Support

Elizabeth Jernigan discussed potential funding opportunities in Davie County using Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) funding. Davie County is eligible for 50,000 in funding over the next two years. We are investigating several projects including a public/private partnership to install truckstop electrification stations for long-haul truckers but we are having trouble finding a location. PART considered adding a route but upon further evaluation decided it was not in the best interest of the riders. Elizabeth also recommended investigating a sidewalk project in Mocksville during the next phase of funding as there was not time to secure match funding prior to the grant deadline. Will Marklin made a motion to adopt the following project list. Kevin Austin seconded the motion. All were in favor.
