Aging and Adult Services and local service providers for state Senior Center General Purpose funding for the period July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016.

Each year after approval by the General Assembly, the North Carolina Division of Aging and Adult Services allocates funding to senior centers based on certification status throughout the region. This year's total allocation to Region G is \$258,400, the highest allocation to any region in North Carolina. Our region's allocation is the result of a high number of senior centers who received Center of Excellence or Center of Merit designation.

The attached chart lists all of the senior centers in the region and the proposed contract amount. Of the 26 senior centers in Region G, there are 19 centers of Excellence, 4 centers of Merit, and 3 noncertified centers. The level of certification dictates the amount of Senior Center General Purpose funds allocated to a senior center. The chart reflects the amount by certification and the appropriate match.
