### **Mocksville Land Development Plan**

The Planning Department requests to enter into contract for planning services with Foothills Planning and Design for providing GIS and plan development support on the Mocksville Land Development Plan. The effort will be led by Foothills Planning + Design, with support from the PTRC Planning department on key planning functions. Contract Amount: \$7,000

RE: Request to terminate retiree healthcare benefit

The Board of Delegates approved a schedule of benefits as a part of the merger process on May 31, 2011 including retiree health benefits. The supplement for retiree health benefits was amended in June of 2015. The Board of Delegates annually authorizes the continuation or discontinuation of the plan as a part of the budget process. The intention of these actions was to extend group health insurance coverage to retirees without placing undue financial burden on PTRC operations. The goal was to allow retirees access to coverage that would be paid by the retiree. The plan was further intended to provide this access to healthcare coverage to retirees less than age 65.

No retirees are currently covered under the plan and PTRC has not had retirees opt for this coverage in over a year.

Changes in the standards for governmental accounting and specifically the requirements that PTRC establish a reserve for post-retirement healthcare benefits have resulted in the recommendation to terminate retiree healthcare coverage. Continuing retiree healthcare would require having an actuarial study completed and establishing a reserve that could exceed \$150,000. PTRC staff consulted with our benefits broker and their technical experts to determine if modifications to the retiree benefit could be made to preserve some semblance of a benefit. There were no options available, therefore, the recommendation of staff is to terminate retiree healthcare benefits retro-active to July 1, 2017. This action will avoid having to incur costs of the actuarial study for fiscal year 2017-2018.
