# **Updates**

- USDA grant is looking good, with official announcement in September \$35K, Branding and marketing with website, portal for food council and associates, some funding to start the assessment
- In June, PTRC will touch base about the Power Grant initiative
- Great start to leverage other funds

- We reviewed draft member application with these suggestions:
  - Define Local Food Ambassador. Language in beginning was removed.
  - Explain term limits again by the question on the application.
  - Make sure outreach is appropriate for youth and all other stakeholders that we would like represented.
  - Given that the <u>demographic information</u> was optional and all applicants may not complete it, we decided we couldn't use this information for comparing applications.
     Therefore we decided not to include the demographic questions, and incorporate this idea into question #3 about describing their perspective, experience, and skills.
- Decision on membership selection committee proposal
  - Matthew offered to remove himself from the selection committee to create a more diverse selection committee.

**Proposal:** Joe, Gini, Matthew, and two or more others (at least one being a food council member in the Triad) will comprise the membership committee. This group will use the existing criteria created, complete the Membership Application Scorecard, and draft a recommendation. Participating on this committee will require reviewing and ranking all membership applications and at least one other inperson meeting or phone call outside of our monthly meetings. This committee's recommendation will be brought to the existing Advisory Committee, who will make the final decision.
