New PART Express Inclement Weather Plan



In an effort to be ready for adverse weather conditions. PART has created a three-tiered Inclement Weather Plan.

Tier 1: Route will begin late or be cancelled. **Tier 2:** Route will be limited during the day, starting late, and ending early. Some routes cancelled. **Tier 3:** Route will end early. In extreme cases, we may need to cancel all PART Express service.







January PART Express Ridership totaled 37,353





Piedmont Triad Regional Travel Demand Model Training

On January 30, 2020 PART hosted a training for 23 NCDOT Division Office personal. The training focused on the Regional Travel Demand Model and was framed as an information exchange about travel demand model inputs and outputs, the process of project traffic forecasting and most importantly how the two work together.

Scott Rhine, PART's Executive Director, opened the training with a welcome and then set the stage for the training. John Kim, PART's Regional Modeler, presented a detailed description of how the model



works centered on the purpose and significance of accurate socio-economic data. Then Mark E. Kirstner, PART's Director of Planning discussed a new process for developing the socio-economic data utilizing a tool. The session closed with a question and answer period. Attendees were able to earn 2.0 continuing education credits.

New Buses In PART Express Fleet

New bus alert! Four 2020 New Flyer Xcelsior buses will go into rotation on routes by the end of March. These buses are state of the art with high back reclining seats, USB charging stations on each seat, kneeling feature for easy boarding, FREE WiFi, 10 security cameras, and super comfortable ride.

Six new shuttle vehicles are coming soon too! The replacement buses and shuttles are replacing older fleet.








FEATURED ROUTE OF THE MONTH - ROUTE 2

Route 2 Greensboro Express provides a vital link between Downtown Greensboro and the job centers around Hwy 68/Airport Area. Route 2 runs Monday-Saturday connecting the Greensboro Depot, Four Seasons Town Centre, and the Coble Transportation Center (CTC).
